



Dear Compulsory students and parents,

Our Lucia concert is fast approaching . . . here are some final details and reminders.

reminder – Each child should “get” a **costume**. Girls will wear a traditional Lucia nightgown with a glitter band around the waist and in their hair; Boys should also wear a Lucia nightgown with a traditional star boys’ hat. If you do not have one or cannot borrow from a friend, the school has girl costumes which can be borrowed at no cost – contact bbergin@ssb.be

reminder – Students are **rehearsing songs** for the concert in their music classes. The songs and the texts are posted on schoolsoft/homepage. Any extra practice at home is greatly appreciated!

December 9th – **General Rehearsal at school from 13.00 – 14.00***. Students will finish their regular school day at 12.00. They will have a 30 minute play break outside supervised by our out-of-school care team together with many parent volunteers. At 12.30, we will serve the students lunch and then have rehearsal with the entire group from 13.00 – 14.00. This is an earlier dismissal than our original letter stated. After 14.00, we will go back out with our students for (supervised) free play until they can be picked up or ride home with the bus.

December 11th – **General Rehearsal in the Sports Hall from 14.00 – 15.40**. This is a regular school day and all of our children will be supervised by our staff. But, this is an important practice because this is when we will learn where to stand and what to do during Sunday’s big event.

December 13th – the BIG day – Our students will **gather at 15.30** in the Sports Hall to dress and prepare all of the last minute details. Our parents are welcome to drop off or wait in our café which will be open both before and after the concert. The **Lucia Concert officially begins at 17.00**.

reminder - There will be a small entrée fee of 5 euros per adult. Tickets can be purchased in our reception. Children will, of course, enter free of charge. Parents who help backstage get in free of charge. Following the concert, we will offer all of our fantastic students and their families, as well as our visitors a treat of *glögg* and *pepparkakor*.

The students have been working hard preparing – and are looking forward to this big event.
